What is the fediverse?

It's all connected!



A **decentralized** (federated) web publishing tech that:

- operates across **independently run servers** (instances) that
- maintain an underlying **interoperable framework**
- where users create “**open**” identities
- to allow the formation of **one global social network, blog, or website.**



What is Mastodon?

- A free, open-source decentralized social media platform
- Anyone can launch a server and operate an instance

Who “owns” Mastodon?

- No one... kinda.
- Code base is OSS (APGL v3)
- Code is IP owned by Eugen Rochko & other Mastodon contributors

What is ActivityPub?

- An open source protocol standard developed by the World Wide Web Consortium (W3C)
- Allows servers running Mastodon, or other federated tech, to communicate and exchange data with other platforms (such as diaspora*, Tumblr) using an agreed-upon protocol

Legal Checklist

How to run a compliant platform



What's involved?

Domain Name

A traditional domain name from a domain name registrar.

Therefore, ICANN rules, processes, and procedures apply.

Hosting Provider

Typically a virtual private server, or VPS, can be used.

There are many companies now offering “one-click” type hosting solutions, similar to launching a WordPress or similar website.

Email Server

Mastodon requires an email server for sending communications to users.

Storage Server

Optional, but most instances will need a separate storage server for user files (think AWS)



Any additional elements?

Business Entity

It could be potentially helpful from an operational standpoint, and to mitigate personal liability and risk.

Registered Agent

Registering a designated agent with the U.S. Copyright Office to take full advantage of the DMCA safe harbor of copyright infringement claims start coming in.

User Policies and Guidelines

Can include a copyright policy (and repeat infringer policy), a trademark policy, a content moderation policy, and other basic operational concerns larger platforms manage.

Regulatory, Security & Privacy

Establishing a baseline (ideally comprehensive) set of standards for dealing with COPPA, child sexual abuse material (CSAM), security, and privacy (GDPR, CPPA, etc.) will be important.
